

Values Bingo Teacher Instructions

Cut apart the values below on the dotted lines. Place all of these in a bag. Each student will need a bingo card and a marker to cross off the values that have been called. To play the game, pull a value out of the bag and read the definition. Students can then call out which value they think it corresponds to, and the teacher should confirm when they have guessed the correct one. Then students can cross that value off of their bingo card. When a student has five boxes in a row, column, or diagonal crossed off, they have a bingo.

You tell the truth; You are honest in all areas

You think of others and say things to encourage others instead of hurting their feelings

Loyalty

You don't speak badly about your family, teachers, classmates, & school

Patriotism

You stand at attention with your eyes on the flag

Perseverance

You don't give up even though something is hard

Respect

You take care of other people's property

Responsibility

You can be depended upon

Reverence

You show respect during prayers.....you don't talk or fidget or laugh

Sincerity

You mean what you say you are genuine.

Sportsmanship

You don't argue with the coach ... you congratulate the winners, You include others and don't change the game rules when someone joins the game

Unselfishness

You share parts, time, attention with others.....you are not greedy

Considerate

You think about how your actions will affect others around you before doing it

Fair

You give equal sized pieces of treats to all of your friends

You include a new student in your discussion and/or game
